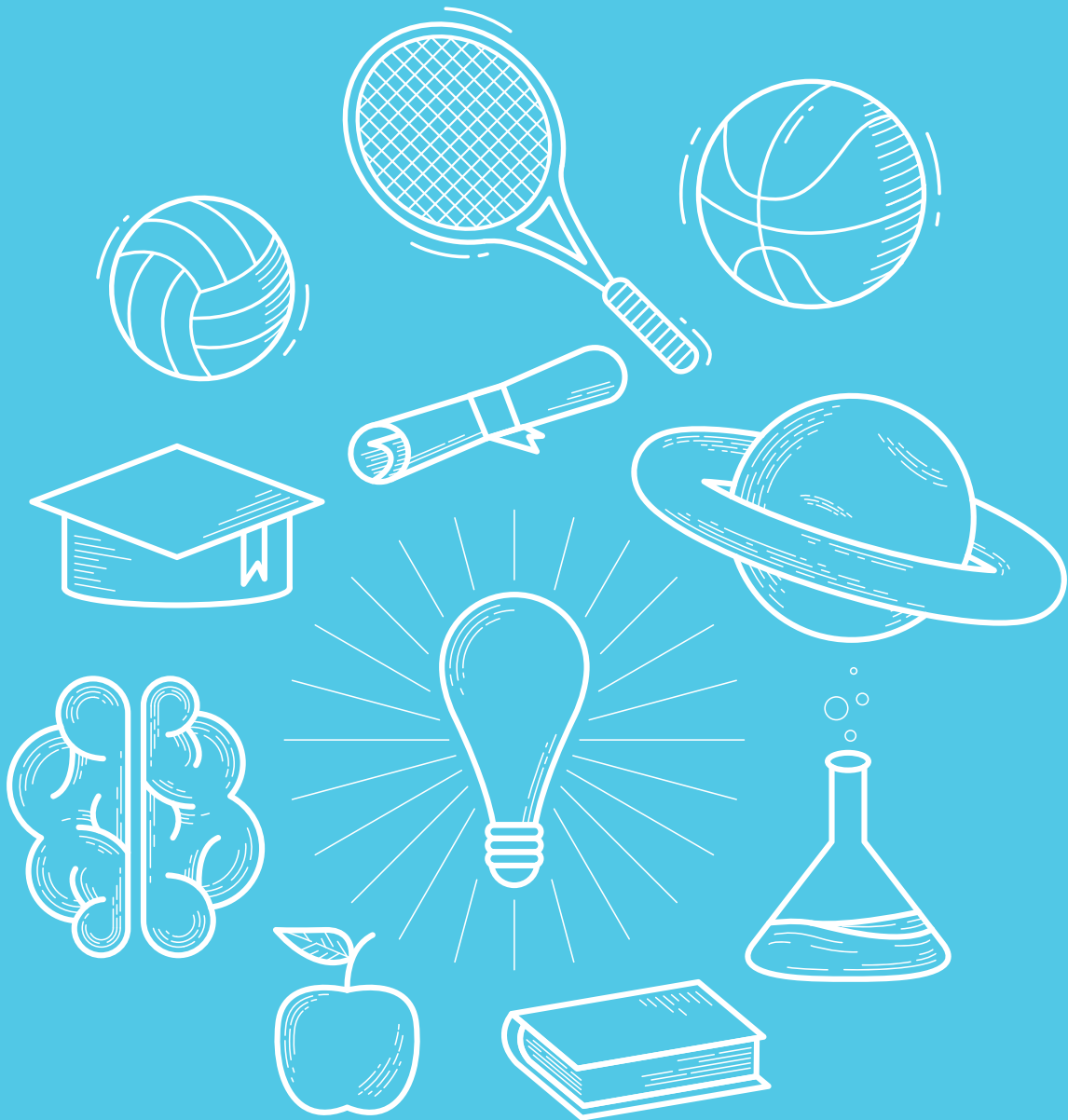

At GEMS Education Egypt, 4 types of scholarships are offered.

Academic University Awards for graduates of British International Schools

10% of tuition fees

GEMS Egypt reserves the right to offer a Foundation Scholarship of up to 100 % fee remission to an exceptional student on a case-by-case basis.

School Scholarships for Years 10, 11, 12 of British International Schools

Students who are eligible to receive the scholarships must have more than 85% attendance



School Scholarships for Years 10, 11, 12 of British International Schools

The following scholarships are awarded to internal as well as external students, subject to places available in year levels:

1. Academic Scholarships



Total of 10 Academic Scholarships: 10 students from Years 10, 11, 12 in the initial year across both British Schools

50% School Fee Remission

For a maximum of four students each year

25% School Fee Remission

For a maximum of six students

ACADEMIC ELIGIBILITY

- An average of, not less than 90% in both -- Year 9 end of year result (i-Lower/Pre-IGCSE) and the Year 10 1st term result (or equivalent for external students).
- An exceptional record in extra-curricular activities in the areas of STEM, Debating, Sports, Performing Arts or Visual Arts or any other area considered by the Scholarship Committee.
- For new school applicants, scholarships will be awarded based upon the same criteria as above based upon reports from the applicant's previous school.
- An excellent role model and ambassador for the school in all areas, with concrete examples of taking on leadership opportunities within the school and/or local community.
- All short-listed applicants will have an interview-based upon the above criteria with the Heads of Secondary and School Principals.
- All applicants must have an average of 85% attendance at school

2. Co-Curricular Scholarships



Total of 4 Co-curricular Scholarships: 4 students from Years 10, 11, 12 in the initial year across both British Schools

15% School Fee Remission

Awarded for outstanding contribution in any aspect of the school's co-curricular programmes, for example, STEM, Sports, Performing, and Visual Arts. Official recognition from outside organizations will be reviewed and maybe taken into account, if appropriate.

One of the above maybe A World Academy of Sport Scholarship, which will be awarded for an exceptional athlete, who represents Egypt at a national level, whilst maintaining a high level of commitment and leadership in the school context.

ACADEMIC ELIGIBILITY

- Excellence in the designated area as supported by recommendations from school staff and interviews by the Heads of Secondary and School Principals.
- A satisfactory (passing) standard of academic progress is also required.
- All applicants must have an average of 85% attendance at school

3. Top Attendance Scholarship



2 Top Attendance Scholarships for each British School (50% School Fee Remission)

- This is a prestigious financial award and is granted to a select number of students in Year 11 and Year 12 recognized for their high attendance rate and commitment to school.
- Awarded students will have the opportunity for summer internships at EEP during the first two summers of university.

ACADEMIC ELIGIBILITY

- An average attendance rate of not less than 90% in all IGCSE/A-Level courses.
- An average grade of not less than 6 in all external examinations taken in IG/AS or A-level.
- An excellent role model and ambassador for the school in all areas, with concrete examples of taking leadership opportunities.
- All short-listed applicants will undergo an interview based on the above criteria with the Heads of Secondary and School Principals.



4. Academic University Awards for Graduates of British International Schools

These are financial awards given to a select number of graduating students, who have gained a confirmed place at one of the world's most competitive institutions.

They provide recognition for outstanding academic and co-curricular achievement and provide an opportunity to openly celebrate the annual achievement of the school.

A GEMS Egypt Higher Education Scholarship will be provided for a maximum of 2 students per annum (based upon highest-ranking university placement) for the first year of study which will amount to an award of 10% of the annual tuition fee cost up to EGP 100,000 GBP 5,000 per scholar.

ACADEMIC ELIGIBILITY

- An average of not less than A/A* or 9/8 in all external examinations taken in GCSE/IGCSE/AS and A Level
- An exceptional record in extra-curricular activities in the areas of STEM, Debating, Sports, Performing Arts or Visual Arts or the equivalent
- An excellent role model and ambassador for the school in all areas, with concrete examples of taking on leadership opportunities within the school and/or local community
- All applicants must have an average of 85% attendance at school

An unconditional confirmed placement at one of the world's or Egypt's most competitive universities and a confirmation of attendance. These universities will usually be defined as one of the top 50 institutions in the Times World University Rankings as published on an annual basis, but GEMS Egypt reserves the right to offer this award for any notable higher education placement
