




# 3. How can a teacher encourage his/her students to think innovatively?



In response, we introduced upgrades to the playground flooring, in addition to investing in new garden toys, adding a layer of fun and enjoyment to the time our young students spend outdoors.

While at GEMS TBS, a series of renovations were carried out to uplift several aspects of the school, including the school building facade, reception area, and theater stage extension. Moreover, the admissions office was upgraded, and new ones were constructed.

Like GEMS BISM, the kindergarten area was refurbished, and new playground toys were installed. Ensuring that all the schools' facilities are running seamlessly, Madinaty Language School (MLS) and Madinaty Integrated Language School (MILS) have undergone needed infrastructure updates, indoor renovations, and supplying













extra furniture to meet the needs of the increasing number of students. Meanwhile at Westview and Scholars International Language Schools (WILS and SILS), we added designated bike tracks covering approximately 225-meter squares, dedicated for kindergarten students, augmenting their school experience and promoting physical activity and wellbeing. This novel initiative, seldom found in national schools, reflects our commitment to cultivating an environment that promotes academic excellence alongside healthy habits. 


### **Career and Industry Day**














### Pioneering Excellence:

#### The First IB School in Alexandria

The responsibility of AIA is to offer the highest quality and standard of education in Alexandria. To promote excellence in the next generation. To inspire them to be lifelong learners. When AIA was founded, there was no doubt that the IB program would be the foundation upon which it built its reputation and results.

The IB program was created to provide a globally recognized education that would deliver students with a well-rounded education, which prepares students for higher education and the challenges of the real world. To reach this goal, an IB education includes a broad range of subjects and other diverse topics such as the theory of knowledge and community service. It promotes critical thinking, creativity, and a sense of global citizenship. As a result, the IB is highly respected by universities and employers, and IB students are often sought after for their strong academic skills, critical thinking abilities, and global perspectives.

This is not just empty talk; it is supported by multiple studies. For example, in the UK, DP students are three times more likely to enroll in a top-20 university, 40% more likely to obtain an honors degree, and 38% more likely to pursue further study, when compared to A-Level students (Duxbury et al., 2021). In the US, DP students are also more likely to enroll in higher education, and have more success once enrolled (Pilcher, Caspary, Woodworth 2020).

But it's not only about the system, it's about how the school implements that system. Here's what some of our own parents have to say about AIA:

"The whole staff are very helpful and keen to assist both me as a parent and my son to understand the system and engage in it quickly. Discipline and values that are applied not just slogans. Activities and skills introduced at all ages."

"Because it is the best educational system in Alexandria and the school applies it very well."

"I am truly impressed with everything. Maximum care is given to each student, whether related to education or emotions. I have recommended the school, and many of my friends enrolled their kids this year."

AIA just graduated its very first group of students, and their DP results were significantly above the world average. In the younger grades, AIA students perform above international averages on independent standardized tests such as the NWEA's MAP.

Through the hard work of its staff, support of the community, and implementation of IB pedagogy, AIA is the premiere IB school in Alexandria.


#### How Innovation Week Empowers Students to Make a Real Difference




